

Community Notice Board

The CCA community notice board is located on Council Road Reserve land, in front of Sails at Clayton Bay. It is a two sided signboard with lockable, clear polycarb doors covering pin boards.

The Secretary of the CCA is the responsible officer for the Community Notice Board.

The key to the Notice Board will be kept by the Secretary and President of the Association, and/or their nominee.

Community News

The community news side of the Community Notice Board will be the side facing Sails. It should contain:

- Public information regarding CCA activities
- Public information from the Council or any other community service groups
- Public information relating to hall and community social activities
- Local business, business cards (3 months free posting, after which, the card may be replaced or removed)
- Any other information sanctioned by the CCA Management Committee, including classified advertisements (Maximum A5 size)

Community Advertising

The community advertising side of the Community Notice Board will be the side facing away from Sails.

Non-Clayton related advertisements will not be permitted. Advertisements by a business that directly competes with Sails of Clayton Bay will not be permitted.

All advertising must be sanctioned by the CCA Management Committee before it is posted.

Each advertising block can be purchased for minimum period of three months. If further periods have not been purchased, the advertising will be removed by the CCA Secretary and replaced with a notice stating *"Please contact the CCA Secretary if you want to advertise here. The Secretary can be contacted C/- PO Clayton SA 5256"* or similar.

A three month A3 space will cost \$25 and a three month A4 space will cost \$10 and payment is required before any advertising is posted. Invoicing and receipt of advertising money will be through the CCA Treasurer.

Inaugural sponsorship advertising will be determined by the CCA Management Committee.
